

Who am I?

Flags

Try to guess which flag is described. All the flags are from countries around the World Showcase at EPCOT

1. I am white with a large red disk (representing the sun without rays) in the center
2. I have three equal vertical bands. From left to right, they are green, white, and red. I also have a coat of arms, an eagle perched on a cactus with a snake in its beak, centered in my white band
3. I have three equal vertical bands. From left to right, they are blue, white, and red
4. I have two identical vertical bands of red (on both the left and right), with a white vertical band between them. My white band is twice the size of one red band. There is an 11-pointed red maple leaf centered in the white band
5. I have three equal horizontal bands. From top to bottom, they are black, red, and gold
6. I have a blue field with the red cross of Saint George edged in white superimposed on the diagonal red cross of Saint Patrick, which is superimposed on the diagonal white cross of Saint Andrew
7. I am red with a green pentacle (five-pointed, linear star) known as Sulayman's (Solomon's) seal in the center
8. I have three equal vertical bands. From left to right, they are green, white, and red
9. I have 13 equal horizontal stripes of red (from top and bottom) alternating with white. There is also a blue rectangle on my upper left-side corner bearing 50 small, white, five-pointed stars.
10. I am red with a blue cross outlined in white that extends to the edges of the flag; the vertical part of my cross is closer to the left of the flag (it is not centered)

I am red with a large yellow five-pointed star and four smaller yellow five-pointed stars (arranged in a vertical arc toward the middle of the flag) on my upper left-side corner
